All In and Moving Forward

To be a successful business person you have to be *all in*. Ron Davis knows this from personal experience. After working for several successful businesses Ron and his wife Marta found themselves stepping out to run their own computer

software firm. Highly successful in their Southern California

based business, they would work hard all week long, living for the weekends.

During that time neither Ron nor Marta believed in Christ. Later they were drawn to Christianity of the Evangelical Pentecostal flavor. Through a series of events, including the horrific Northridge earthquake, they ended up moving to Southern Oregon in 1995.

They were living in a motorhome in the woods and one of the very few stations they were able to view was Better Life Television, a 3ABN downlink station developed by some lay members of the Grants Pass Adventist church. Neither Ron

TV, but one day Ron caught a program with Doug Bachelor and and said to Marta, "You've got to come hear this." It wasn't long until they started watching the channel regularly.

They soon found that their conception of Christianity was being challenged. As they listened, watched and studied their Bible, they concluded that the Seventh-

It is easy to give support to a child like this when you see the glaring need isn't it? I've met many just like this - not physically, but starving


with soul hunger for the bread of life. Their souls are just as emaciated and you can see it in their poor choices and pained experiences. They too are hungry.

QuestLine Productions is looking for approximately 5 acres in a more rural setting (and we're praying for a view). It needs to be within a short distance of an airport and near hotels that will house the language groups coming for their filming.

day Adventist message was God's truth as presented in His Word. So they started attending the Grants Pass Seventh-day Adventist Church and were soon baptized.

With time on their hands they chose to volunteer at the same station that had brought them to the truth - Better Life Television! It wasn't long before BLBN was looking for a Station Manager. People kept saying, "Ron, Marta, you should do it", but they really weren't interested as it was completely outside their previous fields of experience. They prayed and continued to pray about it and eventually committed to helping fill the gap for a short time.

It didn't take long until Ron's concern about taking this position was confirmed. He wasn't really happy in this new role. He was sure the Lord had a work for him to do, but it certainly wasn't television. So he prayed about it and God said, "Well you're *not* all in." At that point Ron said, "OK Lord, I'm *all in*." From then on, both Ron and Marta truly felt the joy of the Lord and it became their strength.

Even though they were new Adventists and knew very little about the Adventist organization or how to run a television station, they were now *all in* and God started doing miracles! A "short" 15 years later Better Life Broadcasting Network had grown from 5 stations to 22 stations covering 84% of the population of Oregon and parts of Nevada and California, all with never an unpaid bill or a missed payroll.

Five years later, and well into their retirement, they find themselves in a new faith-building endeavor. After the Grants Pass Church recently voted to make the *I Met God* video Bible study series for the languages of the world one of their world mission projects, God called them to once again be *all in!* Ron believes this is an extraordinary opportunity to reach the world in a way that no one has previously considered; using new technology, providing the ability for different cultures to present the gospel message to their own people, in their own costumes, in their own language.

Ron says, "This is incredible! When Pastor Byrd asked us to help, why wouldn't we, it's a no brainer! From some little town in Oregon we can do something like this for the world. This is gigantic! We have the opportunity to help provide the way for Jesus to say 'I'm coming' and to hasten His soon return. And this is not huge amounts of money. Jesus does say, 'Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel and then the end will come.' So, if we can help in some way why wouldn't we? Marta and I are *all in*. We get a front row seat to see what God will do next, but only as we move forward in faith." \sim Carrie Hise - IMG Team

Dick's Story

Dick, age 92, always believed that there was a "higher power" out there but really didn't give it much thought. Some even thought he was an atheist though he never

self-identified as one. Two of his best friends growing up were Seventh-day Adventists who left a positive, life-long impression on him. He said, "They were good boys".

For years Dick struggled with alcoholism but with determined effort and a higher power he was soon to meet, he was finally able to gain the victory over it.

A couple of years ago he was in a terrible car accident, breaking his neck, shoulder, clavicle, and some ribs.

His Seventh-day Adventist landlord, seeing an opportunity to minister to her tenant, started offering him some guidance on how to enhance the healing of his body. These encounters led to conversations about the Scriptures.

Enter . . . the beauty of a church that has embraced *Thunder* evangelism! Pastor Jason Logan was inserted as a local host into the *Thunder in the Holy Land* series a few years ago and his members have been engaged in conducting small group *Thunder* studies. Dick was invited to join one of these small groups where he learned many things about God and had many questions answered. He decided he wanted to make a complete commitment to the God he had learned about by being baptized.

Pastor Jason had planned public evangelism meetings to wrap up the small *Thunder* groups followed by a baptism. Dick was certainly looking forward to it. This

decision took place right as the COVID-19 pandemic locked everything down so unfortunately his baptism was delayed.

Finally after two months Dick said, "I HAVE to get baptized no matter what! Something bad could happen to me, after all I am 92!" So Pastor Jason baptized Dick on May 16, 2020.

During his baptism Pastor Jason shared that Dick was the candidate most advanced in years that he had ever baptized to which Dick answered.

"It's never too late!" Amen to that!

When God's people choose to be proactive in sharing their faith the Lord opens up opportunities. Dick's landlord saw one of those opportunities and engaged with him as a caring friend. Because others were already conducting *Thunder* studies she was then able to connect Dick with one of those groups. That's intentional evangelism! Because there was already a *Thunder* study in progress it was easy to plug him in.
